HCPSS TO REMAIN VIRTUAL THROUGH THIRD QUARTER

During its work session on Monday, November 16, 2020, the Howard County Board of Education voted to continue the Howard County Public School System (HCPSS) in a virtual instructional model through the third academic quarter, which ends April 14, 2021. Additionally, the Board instructed the Superintendent and staff to explore possibilities for expanding and enhancing in-person small group program offerings, with consideration for staff preferences regarding participation. Small group in-person programs serve the needs of students who most benefit from face-to-face instruction and support. More information can be found on the <u>HCPSS website</u>.

THANKSGIVING BREAK MEAL SERVICES: Adjustments for November 23– December 4, 2020

HCPSS will be closed for Parent Teacher Conferences and the Thanksgiving holiday from Wednesday, November 25 through Friday, November 27. To ensure children have access to essential nutrition over the holiday period, families may pick up meals in advance to cover the holiday break.

The following adjustments will be made to meal services:

- There is no meal service Wednesday, November 25-Friday, November 27.
- Meals for November 24-29 will be available for pickup on Tuesday, November 24.
- Pre-ordering will not be available for meals picked up Monday, November 23 or 30. Walk-up (non-pre-ordered) meals may be picked up those and other days schools are in session.
- Pre-ordering services will resume for meals to be picked up beginning Thursday, December 3. Pre-orders for that day must be submitted by Tuesday, December 1, 12:45 p.m.

MEASURES OF ACADEMIC PROGRESS (MAP) REPORTS

Home reports for students who participated in the MAP assessment have been posted in Synergy. Parents/guardians may view/download MAP reports by taking the following steps:

- 1. Log in to HCPSS Connect Synergy
- 2. Select Academic Information from the left panel
- 3. Select Student's Report Cards from the middle
- 4. Near the top of the page, select MAP_2020_WINTER

Note: Students in Algebra I/II or Geometry, and English 8 G/T do not participate in MAP testing and will not have a report displayed. If your child did not participate in the October administration, a report may still appear based on the previous administration.

Free school meals previously due to expire at the end of December, have been extended through the end of the 2020-2021 school year. Thus, HCPSS will be able to provide meals at no cost to any HCPSS student, and all children 18 and under, through the entire school year, assuming continued availability of USDA funding.

UPDATE YOUR FAMILY FILE

Thank you to everyone who has already updated their Family File. We currently have 51% completion! HCPSS uses Family File for parents/guardians to provide emergency information. **Parents/guardians must verify and/or update information annually for each child** and can do so by logging in to <u>HCPSS Connect</u> and selecting the Family File tab and then clicking on Family File.

Once logged in, parents/guardians will be asked to provide or update the following information:

- Student information
- Parent/guardian contact
- Emergency contacts
- Medical information
- Arrival/dismissal procedures
- Media release (photo approval)
- Data confidentiality
- PTA/PTSA directory

Changes of address may not be made through Family File. If you have recently moved, please contact your child's school as soon as possible.
