# DECISION ON INSTRUCTIONAL PREFERENCE FOR REMAINDER OF 2020-2021 SCHOOL YEAR

HCPSS will begin a phased-in transition to a hybrid instructional model beginning March 1. Parents/guardians must make a decision to send their child to school for 1-2 days per week and receive virtual instruction the remainder of the week, or to have their child remain fully virtual for the remainder of the school year. Certain student groups including, but not limited to, students receiving Special Education services and others requiring additional learning support, will have the opportunity to receive in-school learning on 5 days per week. All parents/guardians have the option to have their child continue virtual learning full time for the remainder of the current school year. Click here for more information.

Beginning February 8, 2021, our school is participating in the use of Lightspeed, a
platform and instructional support tool that helps teachers keep students on track and safe as they navigate online learning. <u>Lightspeed Systems Relay Classroom</u> (Links to an
external site.) is a software application that allows a teacher, during specified timeframes,
to control how a student uses their HCPSS-issued Chromebook including viewing

student screens, sharing resources, locking devices, reviewing class activity, and restricting some non-instructional sites. Please read this <u>letter</u> for more information.

Once logged in, parents/guardians will be asked to provide or update the following information:

Student information

- Parent/guardian contact
- Emergency contacts
- Medical information
- Arrival/dismissal procedures
- Media release (photo approval)
- Data confidentiality
- PTA/PTSA directory

Changes of address may not be made through Family File. If you have recently moved, please contact your child's school as soon as possible.
